The company's impressive record in 2023 of 126,650 man-hour worked with zero recordable accidents or injuries, and zero fatalities, brought J.F. Wilkerson to the final selection by NUCA's safety experts.

J.F. Wilkerson is known in the North Carolina region as one of the premier utility contractors, and also one that has as a top company priority employee safety and safety training. Wilkerson achieved NUCA STAR recognition in 2022, and is no stranger to the Feather Safety Awards.

The company has long been recognized and is widely known for their emphasis on safe working conditions, accumulating hundreds of thousands of man hours working safely on their projects in the region.

These protocols, training, and employee self-awareness have all contributed to J.F. Wilkerson's award-winning safety record over the past three decades. The company has won NUCA Safety Awards in 1990, 2004, 2014, 2015, and in 2022.

The William H. Feather Award was created by NUCA in 1978 to honor the contributions of the founding chairman of NUCA's Safety Committee. William Feather. The annual awards are awarded based on the safety

documentation submitted by interested member companies and judged by industry safety professionals.
